BcE Hospitality Management Program

A combined independent-study and on-campus program of instruction in hospitality management leading to multiple certifications and a Baccalaureate Equivalency Diploma (full bachelor degree supplement available):

Accreditation: Confed. of Hospitality & Tourism Int'l Institute of Hospitality OFQUAL (UK gov't accreditation)

Full-time students earn 135 US/UK Credits over 24-30 months, incl. summers

Total Cost, excluding room & board: \$17,995 including all fees, books, etc.

Room & Board (dbl occ) available for \$15,900 for the full on-campus study period (4 semesters)

Financing, outside of the usual financial aid, is available at affordable rates

Associates Degree option, after the independent study portion:

66 of 67 credits (22 courses) of the independent study fully meet the liberal arts guidelines for a US associates degree, per the American Council on Education &/or the NY Board of Regents; from Charter Oak College (CT), Western Governors University, Thos. Edison, etc. Total cost for 2 year associates degree only: under \$5,000.

Bachelor's Degree option, after the full program:

The full BcE program provides UK accredited diploma and an advanced diploma; credentials, we believe, that are as respected, internationally, as a bachelor degree. However, for those students who desire an additional BS/BA credential, the full program facilitates advanced placement for a UK &/or US Bachelor's Degree, w/ 1 year "top-up" (called Level 6 in the UK) study at multiple universities around the world. Colleges exist which can issue either a US or a UK bachelor degree based on the earned courses carrying a combination of US &/or UK credit recommendations & requirements.

55 Courses (w/almost twice the number of specific hospitality courses as the usual HOSP Bachelors curriculum):

8 Hi-Intensity Modules

8 (3 non-credit) foundation courses

Senior Project

328 hours of work-study over 4 semesters, yielding approximately 8-10 credits of the total earned. Additional student labor for full-time students, up to a total of 15-20 hours work per week, is permitted w/o a special waiver.

Exams: CTH assessments are structured, graded & accredited by the Confederation of Hospitality & Tourism itself

Tentative approval has been received for students to study, for 1+ semester, in the UK, Hong Kong, Hungary, Portugal, S. Africa or Sri Lanka for an additional \$500 fee per semester, excl. visa/Rm/Bd/travel.
